Community Standards for:

Window Replacement

- 1. The windows must be single hung vinyl with white frames. Only the lower sash is operable, the windows feature a half-screen and a totally clear view through the top sash. The bottom sash removes completely for safe, easy cleaning.
- 2. The windows must be clear, (not colored or etched) high impact safety glass. If not high impact glass, the windows must have white, accordion type hurricane shutters installed.
- 3. Tinted glass is acceptable.
- 4. The original rough opening size for the windows may not be materially altered during window replacement without the express written approval of the Architectural Review Board.
- 5. The emergency egress opening size of the lower window must meet the minimum Martin County requirements.

Note:

- Touch-up paint color for all exterior walls is Benjamin Moore's Cliffside Gray.
- A Florida licensed and insured contractor must be used for the installation.
- All necessary building permits must be obtained by the contractor from the Martin County Building Department.
- Failure to obtain Architectural Review Board Approval or compliance with the approved specification will result in further expense to the homeowner.
- A copy of the Martin County final inspection, along with a picture of completion, must be submitted to the Eagle Lake Property Manager at:
